- d) Apart from the aforesaid linkage Dakshin Kamrup Girls' College and Chhaygaon College shall collaborate to organize extension and outreach activities like socio economic & welfare initiatives for neighboring & rural communities.
- e) Department of History of Dakshin Kamrup Girls' college, Mirza and Department of History of Chhaygaon College, Chhaygaon will jointly associate for academic collaboration in ICT, Counseling, Training etc. for teachers, staff and students from time to time.
- f) Department of History of Dakshin Kamrup Girls' college, Mirza and Department of History of Chhaygaon College, Chhaygaon will jointly organize awareness campaigns, rallies, streetplays etc. on relevant and burning issues, celebrated important occasions and appreciate good works by offering felicitation to the performers from time to time.
- g) Department of History of Dakshin Kamrup Girls' college, Mirza and Department of History of Chhaygaon College, Chhaygaon will extend for support to the people in distress during any natural calamity of the region, e.g. flood, earthquake, landslides etc.
- h) Department of History of Dakshin Kamrup Girls' college, Mirza and Department of History of Chhaygaon College, Chhaygaon will also work for peace, brotherhood, national integrity and communal harmony.



This MoU is valid for a period of three years from the date of signing of the MoU and can be extended for a period of two years on the recommendation of a review committee. The MoU will automatically lapse after three years, unless renewed.

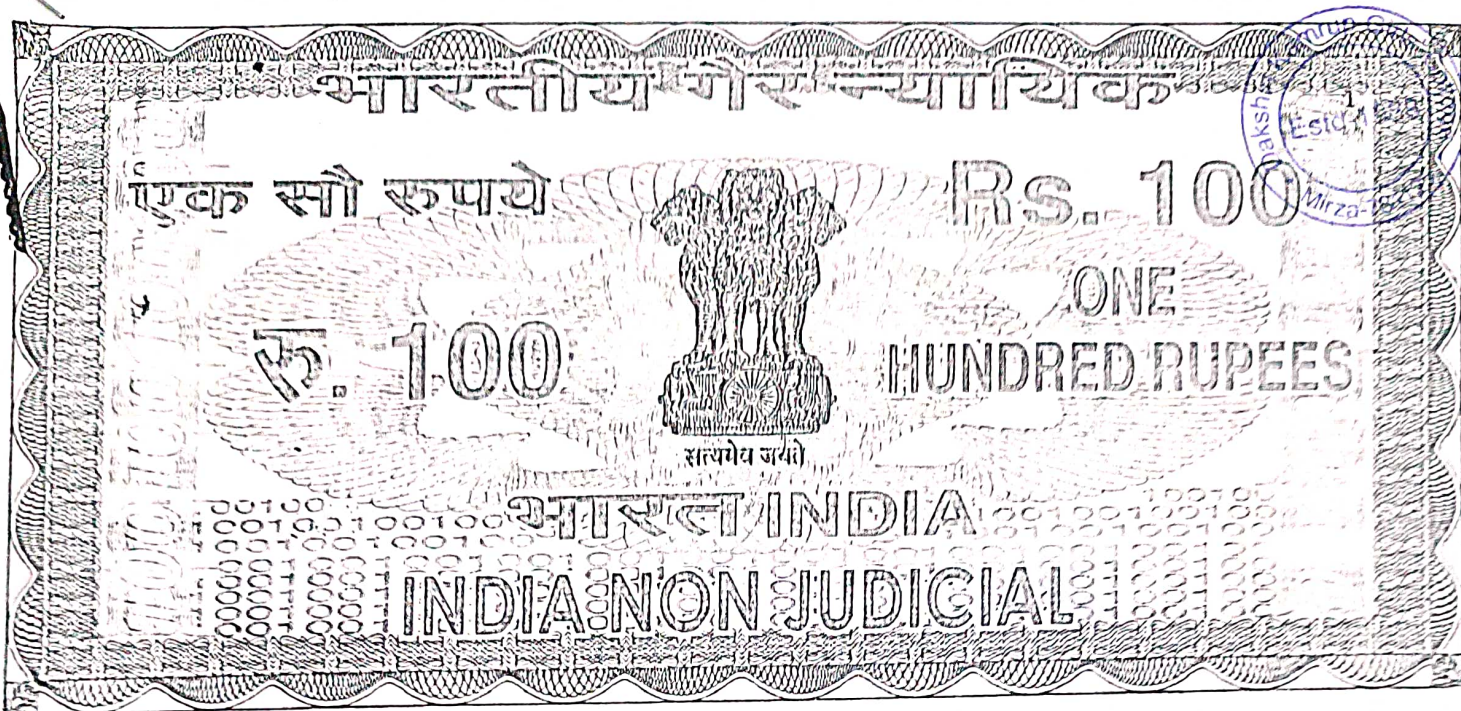

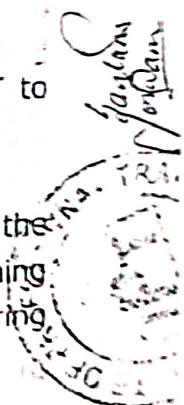
PRINCIPLE OF UNDERSTANDING :

Whereas IPT is desirous to establish a Skill Training Center in Guwahati, Assam in the premise of the college for the purpose of undertaking skill development training activities with a motto to increase employability amongst the youths of the State And whereas the college is interested to start Skill Training Initiatives in the college premise and has earmarked separate premise (building) for the said purpose, for the betterment of the existing / ex-students of the college and the society at large free of cost for the students of the college.

IPT has approached the college for the establishment of a Skill Training Center in the premise of the college and 'College' appreciably agreed to the proposal and both the parties have thus agreed to enter into the following understanding.

1. IPT will offer the **ASSISTANT HAIR STYLIST TRADE** (BWS/Q0201) under Beauty & Wellness Sector of as per the guidelines of **National Skilled Development Corporation (NSDC)** under the **scheme Placement Linked Skilled Development Program (PLSDP)** as implemented by **Assam Skilled Development Mission (ASDM)** in the state of Assam.
2. The entire revenue and capital expenses will be borne by IPT to conduct the courses.
3. The College has earmarked the required infrastructure for the corresponding job role for undertaking skill development training activities within the said premise to IPT for the said purpose during the tenure of this agreement and its subsequent renewals.
4. IPT will, if required as per the job role, seek permission to use the necessary computer laboratory equipments for practical classes.
5. The College permits IPT to display their banner/hoarding/sign board in the said premise along with project specific displays.
6. The College permits IPT to arrange for necessary approvals of the Skill Training Center from concerned regulatory bodies like NSDC/SSC/ASDM etc. as and when required.

8. The College permits IPT to undertake wide publicity through distribution of leaflets, newspaper advertisement display through local cable channels loudspeaker announcement whatsoever for creating local awareness about the purpose of mobilization of beneficiaries.

9. The College permits that IPT may enroll the interested college students into any suitable course on free of cost for the current or ex students.

10. The college permits IPT to depute faculties supervisor, coordinator etc. as per the need of running the Skill Training Center smoothly. IPT will also provide free of cost placement services to the trained and certified students.

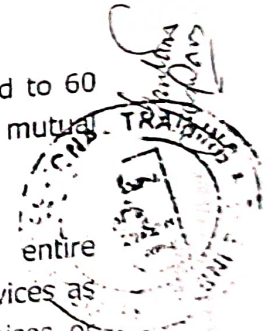
11. **TENURE OF THE AGREEMENT:** This agreement will be valid to 60 months from the day sign up and may be renewed further on mutual consent.

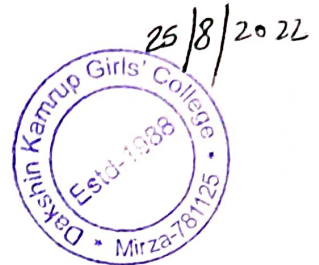

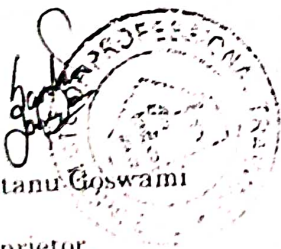

- 6) IPT will maintain the records of the students enrolled.
- 7) In order to ensure the continuation and better accessibility of the courses, we will try to provide them via online mode as well.
- 8) The ownership of all the courses (online or offline), course materials, distribution means, equipments and other related materials solely belongs to IPT.
- 9) This MoU will be active till six months from the date of signing.

 - 1.2.4. ICT Academy shall conduct guest lectures, seminars, workshop and conferences for the teachers and the students in association with university and its colleges
 - 1.2.5. ICT Academy would provide assistance in Research activities to the teachers by way of supervision and collaboration
 - 1.2.6. ICT Academy shall invite the teachers/researchers to submit research papers for publishing in ICTACT Journals
 - 1.2.7. ICT Academy shall invite for research proposals for funding, which shall be applied for joint funding from research funding bodies.
- 1.3. DAKSHIN KAMRUP GIRLS' COLLEGE, MIRZA, ASSAM, shall notify about the program of ICT Academy to its departments and assist in the active participation of the teachers.
- 1.4. DAKSHIN KAMRUP GIRLS' COLLEGE, MIRZA, ASSAM, shall provide the following infrastructure at its campus for some of the training programs, workshops and conferences to be conducted by ICT Academy.
 - 1.4.1. Computer Lab infrastructure (Hardware, software and peripherals)
 - 1.4.2. Training room for conducting the training programs
 - 1.4.3. Conference Hall /seminar Hall/Auditorium
 - 1.4.4. LCD projector and screen.
